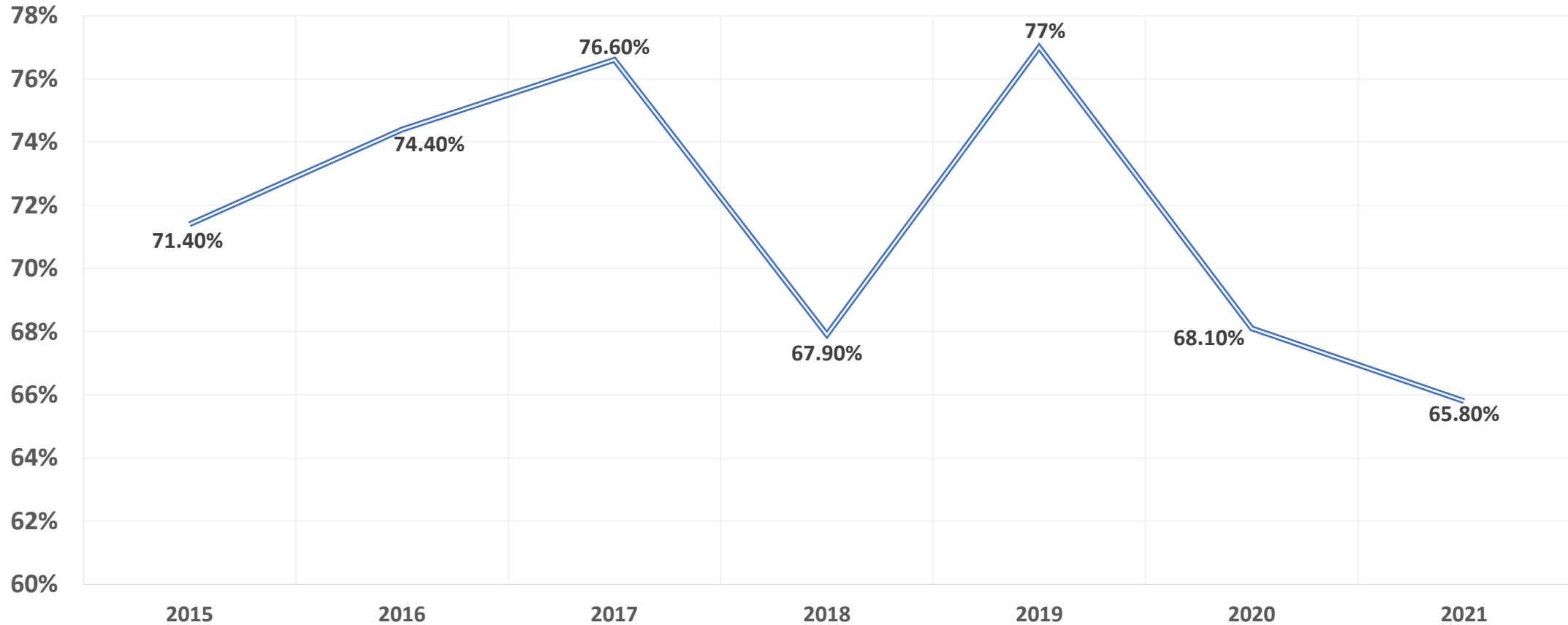

First Time/ Full Time RCOB Retention Rates Cohorts Fall 2015-2021



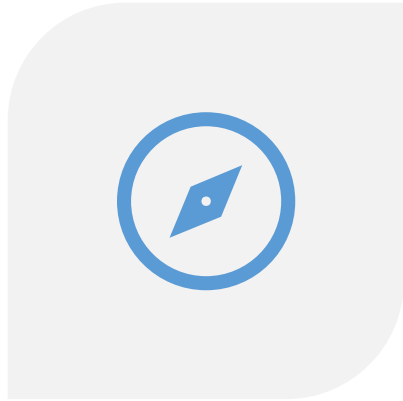

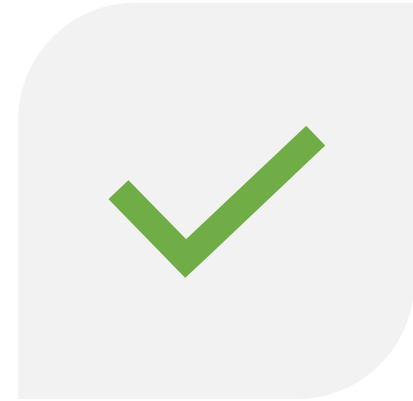

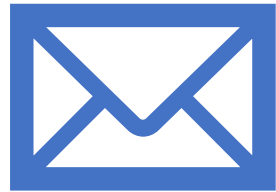


IDENTIFIED RISK FACTORS

Interventions



Passive

Emails and texts both before and after classes started



Active

Grouped with Overall Risk Index and Predicted Academic Difficulties

Intentional interventions

Experimented with a control group

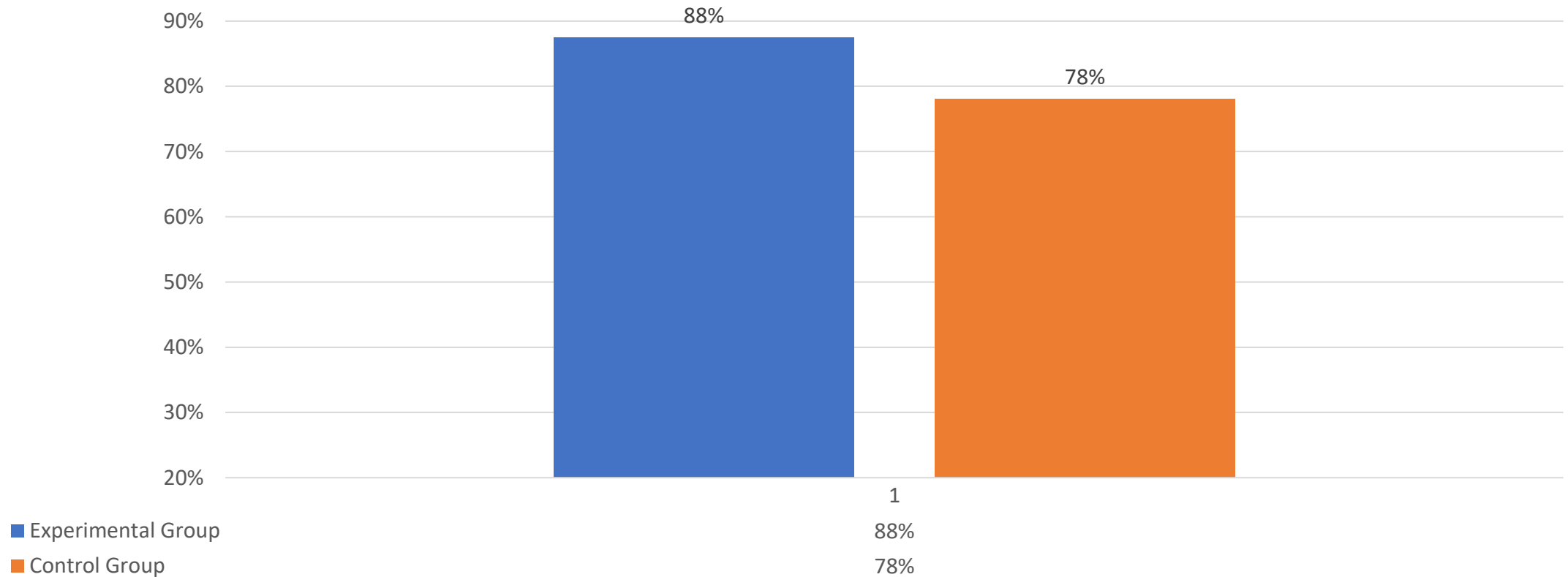
Results -Made Appointments to review CSI

- Overall population- 70 students
 - Experimental group- 56
 - Control- 14
 - 38 of the 56 – 68% actively participated

Results - Registration Advising Appointments

Experimental Group- 49/56

Control- 11/14



Results - Registered for Spring 2023



Targets

- Increase first time/ full time first year student retention
- Decrease first year students on academic probation
